In this issue of our Journal you will find a summary of Dr Kłosowicz observership in Miller School of Medicine in Miami, Florida. She had an extraordinary opportunity to work with Prof. Antonella Tosti — an internationally renowned expert in the field of scalp disorders. This fellowship was funded by the Polish National Science Center grant ETIUDA. Dr Kłosowicz PhD thesis focuses on the value of dendritic cells as predictive markers of responsiveness to hydroxychloroquine treatment in primary cicatricial alopecia patients.

It is important for us to encourage young dermatologists to undertake international advanced research as the exchange of scientific expertise and new multicenter collaboration are vital for the development of Polish dermatology.
