

**Figure S1.** Incidence of death at 1-year follow up according to the presence of nosocomial infection (NI) or smoking habits




Figure S2. Incidence of cerebrovascular accident at 1-year follow up according to the

presence of nosocomial infection (NI) or smoking habits





Figure S3. Incidence of new myocardial infarction at 1-year follow up according to the
