Prof. John Horton MB, ChB, FACP graduated in 1957 from the University of Sheffield Medical School in England. He was Research Fellow in Oncology, Albany Medical College and Visiting Scientist, National Cancer Institute. Between 1974 and 1992 he was Professor of Medicine, Albany Medical College. Since 1993 he is Professor of Medicine, University of South Florida and Associate Dean for Education, H. Lee Moffitt Cancer and Research Institute.

Prof. Horton's main fields of interest are: breast cancer care and research, clinical medical oncology, oncology education and preventive oncology. Among many honorable appointments in scientific societies he was the President – American Association for Cancer Education, President – New York State Cancer Programs Association, President – Northeastern Society of Clinical Oncology. He served on many Committees of the National Cancer Institute.

Prof. Horton is the Founding Editor of Cancer Control: Journal of the Moffitt Cancer Center, and Medical Editor of Current Concepts in Oncology and Clinical Cancer Briefs. He is also a Member of Editorial Boards of The Journal of Cancer Education, Cancer Detection and Prevention and Internal Medicine, Clinical and Laboratory and Reviewer to such journals as Archives of Internal Medicine, Cancer, Cancer Treatment Reports, JAMA, Journal of Clinical Oncology, Mayo Clinic Proceedings and Journal of Neurooncology.

Constantine P. Karakousis M.D. Ph,D. is a graduate of the University of Athens, Greece, Doctor of Medicine degree in 1963. He subsequently received a Ph.D. degree from the State University of New York at Buffalo, Buffalo, NY on Experimental Pathology in 1986. After completion of his residency in General Surgery in June,1973, he joined the staff at the Roswell Park Cancer Institute where he worked until 1995. He was Chief of the Soft Tissue-Melanoma Service at Roswell Park from 1977 through 1995. He has been a Professor of Surgery in the SUNY at Buffalo system since January" 1997 along with being Director of Surgical Oncology for the Kaleida Health system in Buffalo, NY since March,1995 and Chief of the Division of Surgical Oncology, State University of New York at Buffalo, from June 1, 2001 to present.

Dr. Karakousis has currently co-edited a book entitled: "Surgical Oncology: Principles and Practice", which appeared in print in February, 2001 (McGraw-Hill). Previously, he co-edited an "Atlas of Surgical Oncology" (WB Saunders Co.1995) and wrote an "Atlas of Operations for Soft Tissue Tumors" (McGraw-Hill, 1985). In addition, he has published over 250 peer-reviewed papers in the medical literature and presented over 200 abstracts at
