Information Clause on Data Processing

Pursuant to article 13 of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (UE) 2016/679 of 27th April 2016, on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (hereinafter: "GDPR"), the Polish Society of Oncology would like to inform as follows:

- The controller of the personal data is the Polish Society of Oncology with the registered office in Warsaw (hereinafter: "Controller"), with the office address: ul. Roentgena 5, 02-781 Warszawa (Poland), registration data: District Court for the capital city of Warsaw in Warsaw; Division No.: 13 for Commercial Affairs of the National Court Register. KRS [register number]: 0000092357; NIP [tax identification number: 951195543; phone: 508 978 310, e-mail: nikola.jennek@pto.med.pl
- 2. The Controller is the organiser of the competition: "Best Original Paper Award" (hereinafter: "the Competition").
- 3. The Controller shall process the following categories of personal data of the Competition participants and laureates: name, last name, email address.
- 4. The personal data will be processed by the Controller for the purposes resulting from the legally justified interests executed by the Controller and or by third parties, with the exception for the situation in which the interests or the basic human rights and freedoms of the person in question, take precedence over the interests pursued by the Controller and or by third parties, and when these interests and rights require special protection, in particular when the person whom the above data concern is a minor, as stipulated in article 6 item 1 letter f) of GDPR.
- 5. The prospective recipients of the personal data are external service providers of the Controller. The data may be rendered available to them for the purposes connected with such services as data analysis, providing IT technologies and related infrastructure, customer service, performing audits in the scope that is necessary for processing personal data as stipulated in point 3. Moreover, personal data may be rendered available to the institutions authorised to obtain these data pursuant to the applicable law.
- 6. Your personal data may be processed for the period necessary for the objectives indicated in point 4, and, after these objectives are achieved for the period obligatory for storing information. When the time period for processing the personal data is defined, the Controller takes into consideration the following criteria: (i) the duration of the legal relationship with the subject of the personal data; (ii) the legal requirements binding for the Controller; and (iii) the legal interest of the Controller (e.g. the binding limitation periods, court disputes or the investigative actions of the regulatory institutions).
- 7. In connection with data processing, the persons whose data are being processed shall have the following rights: the right to access the data (article 15 of the GDPR), the right to correct the data (article 16 of the GDPR), the right to delete the data (article 17 of the GDPR), the right to limit data processing (article 18 of the GDPR), the right to transfer the data (article 20 of the GDPR) and the right to object (article 21 of the GDPR). In the case when these persons decide to exercise the above rights, the Controller shall provide them with the reply concerning the consideration of these applications concerning the execution of these rights without undue delay, yet not later than within one month of the receipt of such an application.
- 8. The person whose data are processed is authorised to provide information about the execution of their rights specified in point 7 in the following manner:

- 10. In the cases when it is considered that data processing breaches the regulations concerning the protection of the personal data, the person whose data are being processed shall have the right to file a complaint to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office with the registered office in Warsaw at the following address: ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warszawa.
- 11. Providing personal data is a necessary condition for the purposes defined in point 4, i.e. participation in the Competition. In the case when the personal data are not provided, it will not be possible to take part in the Competition.
